Strategies and Methods

- Our first step is to gather a core group of teachers to visit locations in Central Florida relating to Seminole Indians. As we explore these locations, the teachers will develop lesson plans geared toward elementary studies of Native Americans.
- Our next step is to upload the lesson plans with source materials on TPS Teachers Network.
- The step after that is to train teachers in local districts to access and use the lesson plans.
