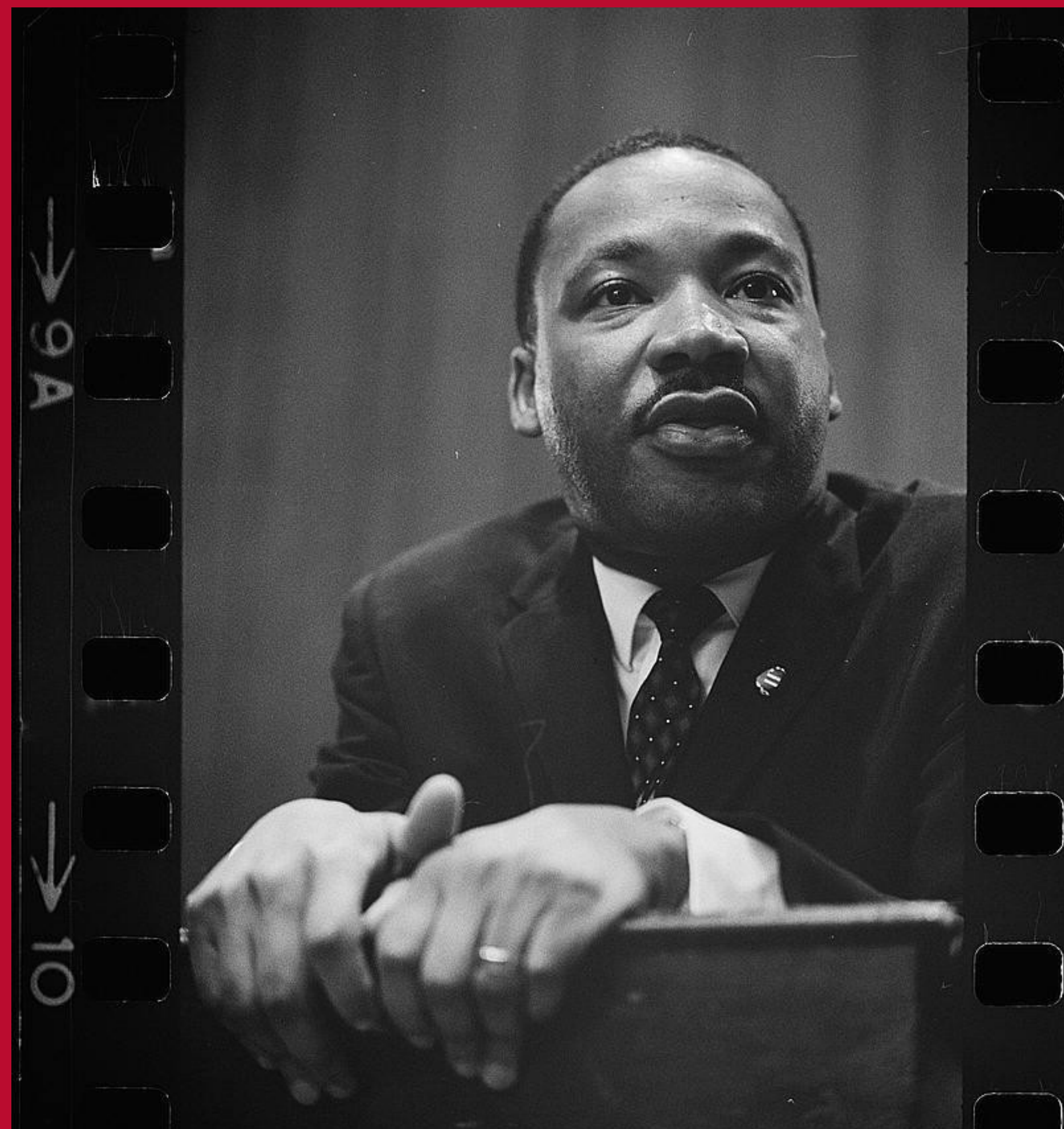

As part of this initiative, teachers in Indiana had the opportunity to examine materials in the archives of the Indiana Historical Society. Educators were able to discuss and view the library's collection of RFK materials, which included original photographs of RFK, 1968 campaign posters and newspapers, and even oral histories of Indiana residents who attended RFK's speech on April 4, 1968. As a result of this experience, teachers were able to incorporate these primary sources into their classrooms, fostering critical thinking, historical analysis, and knowledge of Indiana's history.
